Microsoft backs Cambridge Code Generation conference

Industry giant Microsoft has put their weight behind next May's Code Generation 2007 event by becoming Gold sponsors of the conference, organized by Cambridge-based Software Acumen.

Microsoft's [Domain-Specific Language \(DSL\) Tools for Microsoft Visual Studio](#) will be covered as part of the event. These enable you to create a Visual Studio editor for your own diagrammatic modelling language, with the ability to generate code and other artefacts from the models. You can package the editor, generators, and template projects into an installer for distribution to colleagues.
