Cambridge company generates 2nd successful model-driven development conference

Cambridge-based software consultancy [Software Acumen](#) has just delivered its second successful conference themed around Code Generation and Model-Driven Software Development.

The [Code Generation 2008](#) event took place at Homerton College in Cambridge, from June 25th-27th 2008 and was attended by 120 software specialists from 6 continents. The event was the successor to last year's inaugural [Code Generation 2007](#) event.

CG2008 included 35 different sessions from well-known figures such as Steve Cook of Microsoft, Bran Selic of Malina Software Corp. and independent consultant and author Markus Voelter. Part of the unique attraction of the event is its focus on providing practical advice from experienced practitioners who have successfully delivered projects using cutting edge generation tools and technologies. Participants also valued the opportunity to network with recognized experts in this field to discuss their own particular development challenges in an informal setting.

Other feedback from participants showed that 100% of them thought the event was good value for money with 95% of them saying they had learned something they could apply in their future work and would definitely consider attending a similar event in the future.

This high level of success sends out a strong challenge to Mark Dalgarno who organized the event. After thanking all the speakers, participants and sponsors for sharing their own experiences for the benefit of the community Mark promised to make next year's [Code Generation 2009](#) event – planned for June 2009 again in Cambridge - even more successful.
